### <sup>1</sup>Oasis:

 Oasis T-shirt transformation project update (otherwise known as the doggie chew toy project) –

After collecting approximately 30 t-shirts from the EPC congregation and adding them to the more than 40 t-shirts collected by Oasis, the mission committee and other volunteers gathered after services last Sunday to cut the t-shirts into strips, group them by color and then deliver them to Oasis for their final transformation. Middle schoolers that interact with Oasis met on the 19<sup>th</sup> to braid the t-shirt strips into doggie chew toys that will then be delivered by Oasis to local animal shelters for the benefit of abandoned and abused dogs.

# <sup>2</sup>Maple Village:

- We are still going strong with the produce delivery to Maple Village. Fresh veggies and a plethora of fresh flowers make the residents smile!
- We will be collecting books til the end of September and puzzles til the end of October for an early October and early November delivery to MV.

### <sup>3</sup>Peace and Global Witness Collection

- Collected every fall This Sunday through Oct 1
- Supports peace missions of many types
- EPC keeps 25% for local giving
- You can suggest financial gift recipients to any elder or member of mission committee.
- Proposed recipient is Bridges, a domestic violence women's shelter in Franklin, TN




